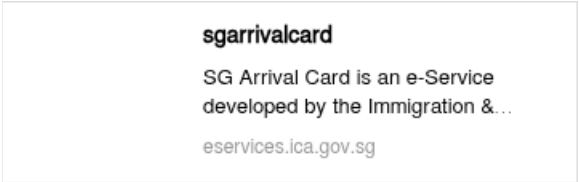

Main Stops

Jewel Changi Airport

Jewel Changi Airport is one of Singapore’s most iconic airport attractions, known for the Rain Vortex, indoor gardens, shopping areas, restaurants, and photo spots. It is a convenient first stop after arrival or final stop before departure.

Kampong Glam

Kampong Glam is a cultural district known for Sultan Mosque, colorful shophouses, Arab Street, Haji Lane, cafés, murals, textile shops, and boutique stores.

Little India

Little India is a lively neighborhood with colorful buildings, Indian restaurants, flower garland shops, temples, markets, and heritage streets. It is a good stop for culture, food, and photos.

Orchard Road

Orchard Road is Singapore’s most famous shopping street, lined with malls, department stores, restaurants, cafés, luxury shops, and budget-friendly retail options.

Main Stops

Singapore Botanic Gardens

Singapore Botanic Gardens is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with wide green spaces, walking trails, tropical plants, lakes, and peaceful garden scenery. The National Orchid Garden is a popular paid section inside the garden.

Merlion Park

Merlion Park is one of Singapore’s most popular photo stops, offering views of Marina Bay Sands, the waterfront skyline, and the Merlion statue.

Marina Bay Sands

Marina Bay Sands is a major Singapore landmark known for its iconic architecture, luxury mall, restaurants, observation deck, waterfront views, and access to nearby attractions.

Gardens by the Bay

Gardens by the Bay is a futuristic garden attraction known for Supertree Grove, Flower Dome, Cloud Forest, outdoor gardens, and evening light shows.

Singapore River Cruise

The Singapore River Cruise gives a scenic view of Clarke Quay, Boat Quay, Marina Bay, Merlion Park, and the city skyline from the water.

Suggested Route

1. Start at Singapore Botanic Gardens.
2. Take MRT to Bayfront or Raffles Place area.
3. Visit Merlion Park.

- 4. Walk or take MRT toward Marina Bay Sands.
- 5. Continue to Gardens by the Bay.
- 6. End with Singapore River Cruise in the evening.

Sentosa is Singapore’s leisure island, known for beaches, attractions, hotels, cable car views, walking paths, photo spots, and entertainment areas.

Universal Studios Planning Notes

- Weekday visits usually have fewer crowds than weekends.
- Early arrival gives more time for rides.
- Water bottle, portable fan, sunscreen, and power bank are useful.
- Express Pass is optional for peak days.
- Dining inside the park is usually more expensive than outside food courts.
